John Redmond in rocking chair, down stage left, afghan over knees, looking at photo album. Three front-row people standing behind chair. Director almost behind the vignette with the chorus turned to left to focus on man in rocker. Hat in left hand, down at side.

(measure 1)

1. Sitting alone in my old rocking chair, No one to love me and no one to care; When life has turned to silver and gray, Old loves, old friends ...

Press; i.e. weight shift to left leg.

Facial involvement important.

Song is reflective,

not real sad.

(measure 15)

2. JUST FADE AVAY.

Director moves to center stage.

Chorus glides into chorus position.

(No jerky moves; no rocking about.)

The three men fade slowly back into front row.

REFRAIN (measure 17)

3. Where have my old friends gone?
